many dishes you can make. This watermelon salad is now easily a company favorite! Super quick to put together on a whim for your next get together.

Watermelon, Basil, Feta Salad

1/2 seedless watermelon
4 ounces feta cheese, crumbled
1/2 cup basil leaves (about 10)
2-4 tablespoons balsamic glaze

- Cut the watermelon into 1" cubes
- Cut the basil leave into chiffonade ribbons
- In a large bowl or platter, arrange watermelon
- Dust the crumbled feta cheese over the watermelon
- Sprinkle basil ribbons over entire dish
- Gently drizzle balsamic glaze over the salad
- Serve immediately
