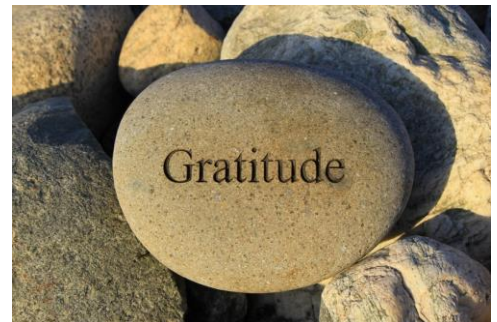

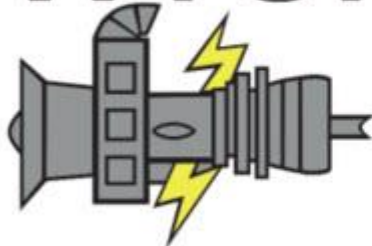

Crockpot Christmas Crack

- 1 (16 oz.) jar unsalted peanuts
- 1 (16 oz.) jar salted peanuts
- 1 (12 oz.) bag semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 (12 oz.) bag milk chocolate chips
- 2 (10 oz.) bags peanut butter chips
- 2 (1 lbs.) packages white almond bark

Layer all ingredients in a large crockpot in order listed above. Turn the crockpot on low, cover with lid, and leave sitting for 2 hours. Then, remove the lid and stir to combine. Replace lid and leave sitting for another 30 minutes. Stir again and then spoon mixture on to wax paper or non-stick aluminum foil. Allow to harden for a least 1 hour. Enjoy!
